TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE UTILIZATION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS TO IMPROVE ACCESSIBILITY TO PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AT THE PARK

Project Location: The Park, 1885 N Hacienda Road, La Habra Heights, CA

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of a Public Hearing to be held on Monday, August 13, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. before the City Council of the City of La Habra Heights in the City Council Chambers, La Habra Heights City Hall located at 1245 N. Hacienda Road, La Habra Heights, CA 90631, to consider and approve utilization of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to improve accessibility to playground equipment at the Park.

The City of La Habra Heights is anticipating an allocation of \$16,343 in CDBG funding for Fiscal Year 2018-19 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development through its participation in the Los Angeles Urban County CDBG Program. Funding for this accessibility project is based on a total unallocated fund balance of \$36,679 in CDBG funds, but the final allocation may vary. A portion of these funds will be expended on a consultant to assist with the submittal and reporting requirements. The proposed project is intended for the installation of rubberized playground flooring for the upper playground at the Park (1885 N. Hacienda Road). The project is intended to enable elderly and severely disabled persons to access the playground equipment.

If you wish to subsequently challenge this matter you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City Council at, or prior to, the public hearing.
